

## A. Monash High Achiever Award (for new students)

### This scholarship is open to:

- Malaysian citizen OR International student
- All undergraduate courses except Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine and Bachelor of Pharmacy.
- Benefits: RM5, 000 tuition fee waiver per semester, subject to maintaining satisfactory academic progress.

### Eligibility: You must meet the following criteria:

- Only new students enrolling into Monash University Malaysia.
- Must have completed an Australian Year 12 qualification or an international senior secondary qualification accepted by the University with an outstanding Australian Tertiary Admissions
   Rank (ATAR) or equivalent, as determined by Monash University Malaysia.

## B. Monash High Achiever Award (for continuing students)

#### **Availability:**

- This scholarship is open to: Malaysian citizen OR International student
- All undergraduate courses except Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine and
  Bachelor of Pharmacy

Benefits: RM5, 000 tuition fee waiver per semester, subject to maintaining satisfactory academic progress.

Eligibility: You must meet the following criteria to stand a chance for nomination:

- Current student of Monash University Malaysia who have completed 2 semesters of study with 48 credit points.
- Have achieved average score of 80% and above from the 8 units completed.
- Fall within the top 1% of the school population.

#### TO RETAIN THIS SCHOLARSHIP

You must maintain the maintenance score stated in your offer letter.



- You must enroll a full load of 24 credit points.
- You must complete the course within the normal duration. No extensions will be permitted.
- You are not permitted to take on other financial assistance at any point of your studies.
- Application Process
- Eligible students will be nominated automatically. Nomination will be carried out every semester. No application is required.

## C. Monash Pharmacy Excellence Scholarship

This scholarship is open to: Malaysian citizen OR International student (Bachelor of Pharmacy)

Benefits: Either 50% or 25% tuition fee waiver for the duration of the course (four years).

Eligibility: You must meet the following criteria:

- Only new students enrolling into Monash University Malaysia.
- Must meet the minimum admission requirements (academic and English Language proficiency) for the course.
- Participation in a non-academic pursuit, extra-curricular activities, and community engagement initiatives are of added advantage.

#### TO RETAIN THIS SCHOLARSHIP

You must maintain the maintenance score stated in your offer letter.

You must enroll a full load of 24 credit points.

You are not permitted to change course.

You must complete the course within the normal duration. No extensions will be permitted.

You are not permitted to take on other financial assistance at any point of your studies.

## D. Graduate Research Pathway Scholarship

- Availability: For all Honors Degree Courses, Postgraduate Diploma in Business and Commerce and Master of Biomedical Science at Monash University Malaysia.
- Benefits: Each scholarship covers 100% or partial of the tuition fees for the duration of the course.
- Eligibility: Applicants with a distinction average in a prior study from a recognized university
  and meet all other entry requirements are eligible to apply for the Scholarships. Selection of
  the scholarship will be based on academic achievement for each discipline as determined by
  Monash University Malaysia.
- Application Process: Interested candidates must apply to the Course Management Office,
   Monash University Malaysia. All applications consistent with the eligibility and selection
   criteria will be considered for a scholarship.
- Application Deadline: As per respective Course Application Deadlines.
- To Retain Scholarship: Students who fail to maintain the required level of performance and fail any one unit in any semester would normally have the full award withdrawn without any reinstatement of the award in the remaining of the study duration.

# E. Master of Professional Counselling Scholarship

- Availability: This scholarship is open to: Malaysian citizen OR International student For Master
  of Professional Counselling at Monash University Malaysia (full-time study only)
- Benefits: Each scholarship covers a partial tuition fee waiver for the duration of the course,
   the amount of which is determined by the School.
- Eligibility: You must meet the following criteria:
  - Must meet the minimum admission requirements (academic and English language proficiency) for the course. Selection will be based on academic achievement as determined by Monash University Malaysia.
- TO RETAIN SCHOLARSHIP:
  - You must maintain the maintenance score stated in your offer letter.
  - o You must enrol a full load of 24 credit points.





- You are not permitted to change course.
- You must complete the course within the normal duration. No extensions will be permitted.
- You are not permitted to take on other financial assistance at any point of your studies.
- Application Process: You must apply to the Course Management Office of the respective Schools at Monash University Malaysia. All applications for admission consistent with the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered for the scholarship.
- Closing date: Applications are open throughout the year. Scholarships are limited and awarded on a competitive basis.

## F. Graduate Research Excellence Scholarship (New students)

- Availability: All Monash Malaysia graduate research students in the following categories:
- o New graduate research students enrolling to Monash Malaysia
- o Current graduate research students at Monash Malaysia in their first year of enrolment
- Benefits: Each scholarship comes with a full tuition fee waiver and monthly stipend of MYR2,800 as follows:
- Research master's degree Two years full-time equivalent from the date of course commencement.
- Doctoral degree -Three years and three months full-time equivalent from the date of course commencement until the scholarship end date or upon thesis submission; whichever is earlier.
- Eligibility:
- Applicants must possess a minimum academic qualification of First Class Honours (H1) or it's equivalence (H1E) recognised by Monash Malaysia.
- Applicants must meet the minimum admission (academic and English language proficiency) and scholarship eligibility requirements as published on the website for the relevant research degree and be enrolled or provided an offer to study at Monash University Malaysia.
- The award of scholarships are based on an applicant's academic record, research output and/or prior research experience.
- Applicants must not have completed a graduate research masters or doctoral degree at the same course level (for example, are applying to undertake a second doctoral degree).





- Applicants who receive a scholarship/financial assistance from an external sponsor(s) must obtain prior approval from the Scholarship office. The Scholarship office will confirm that there are no contradictory conditions from the sponsors. Consent from both MUM and sponsor(s) is required.
- O Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis.
- Application Process: Applicants must initiate the course application process through the
  respective School. All applications consistent with the eligibility and selection criteria will be
  considered for a scholarship.

# H. Graduate Research Tuition Fee Waiver Scholarship (New students)

Availability: All Monash Malaysia graduate research students in the following categories:


- O New graduate research students enrolling to Monash Malaysia
- o Current graduate research students at Monash Malaysia in their first year of registration

#### **Benefits:**

- Either a 50%, 75% or 100% tuition fee waiver up to the duration stated below:
- Research master's degree Two years full-time equivalent from the date of course commencement.
- Doctoral degree Three years, three months full-time equivalent from the date of course
   commencement until the scholarship end date or upon thesis submission; whichever is earlier.

## **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must possess a minimum academic qualification of Second Class Honours (H2A) or it's equivalence (H2AE) recognised by Monash University.
- Applicants must not have completed a graduate research masters or doctoral degree at the same course level (for example, are applying to undertake a second doctoral degree).
- Applicants who receive a scholarship/financial assistance from an external sponsor(s) must
   obtain prior approval from the Scholarship office. The Scholarship office will confirm that





there are no contradictory conditions from the sponsors. Consent from both MUM and sponsor(s) is required.

- Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis.
- Applicants must initiate the course application process through the respective School. All
  applications consistent with the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered for a
  scholarship.

# I. Graduate Research Tuition Fee Waiver Scholarship (Continuing students)

 Availability: Current Monash Malaysia graduate research students progressing from expired externally funded grants.

#### **Benefits:**

- Either a 50%, 75% or 100% tuition fee waiver up to the duration stated below:
- Research master's degree Two years full-time equivalent from the date of course commencement.
- Doctoral degree Three years, three months full-time equivalent from the date of course
   commencement until the scholarship end date or upon thesis submission; whichever is earlier.

### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must have successfully completed all relevant milestones with evidence of research excellence.
- Applicants must have received an industry-funded stipend for a minimum duration of 24 months or at least 80% of the grant duration, whichever is lower.
- Applicants must not have completed a graduate research masters or doctoral degree at the same course level (for example, are applying to undertake a second doctoral degree).
- Applicants who receive a scholarship/financial assistance from an external sponsor(s) must obtain prior approval from the Scholarship office. The Scholarship office will confirm that there are no contradictory conditions from the sponsors. Consent from both MUM and sponsor(s) is required.
- Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis.





### **Application Process:**

- Applications should be submitted 3 months before the stipend support from an external grant is discontinued or expiry of the external grant.
- All applications meeting the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered.
- Please contact your School Research Office to submit an application.

## K. Monash PhD Scholarship (Special scheme supported by KPM)

### **Avaliablity:**

- 20 PhD scholarships worth of RM2.5 million offer to Malaysian government officials who are interested to pursue postgraduate by research degrees (PhD) in priority areas of research at Monash University Malaysia, from the following categories:
- o Academic: Public University, Politeknik (polytechnic) and Kolej Komuniti (community college).
- Non-academic: Any division with job Grade 41 and above.

#### **Benefits:**

Each scholarship covers 100% of the tuition fees.

### **Eligibility:**

- You must meet the minimum admission requirements (academic and English language proficiency) for the relevant research degree. In general, this is equivalent to a distinction average (Honours 2A) from a recognised university in a relevant field. Selection for a scholarship will be based on academic achievement for each discipline as determined by Monash University Malaysia.
- Age requirement: 45 years old and below.
- Admission Criteria: All applicants must be able to demonstrate a capacity to carry out independent research and have adequate training and ability to pursue the proposed course of study. In all cases, the qualifications described below must be from Monash University or an equivalent institution in the opinion of the Graduate Research Committee (GRC).
- Standard entry





- The minimum qualifications for admission to PhD enrolment are:
- a bachelor's degree requiring at least four years of full-time study in a relevant field, and which normally includes a research component in the fourth year, leading to an honours 1 or 2A in a relevant field;
- a course leading to a level rated by the relevant department, faculty and committee as equivalent to an honours 1 or 2A in a relevant field;
- a master's degree that entails work, normally including a significant research component, including at least 25% of one full time equivalent year of work, including a thesis. It is normally expected that a grade of honours 2A has been obtained for the research thesis or project. Where ungraded, examiners' reports will be taken into account; or have qualifications which in the opinion of GRC are deemed equivalent.

### **Application Process:**

- Applications are open throughout the year. Scholarships are limited and awarded to 20
  recipients for full-time study. Applicants must initiate course application process through the
  respective School. All applications consistent with the eligibility and selection criteria will be
  considered for a scholarship.
- For specific contacts, areas of study, application guide within each School

## **Conditions:**

The Monash PhD Scholarships are tenable at Monash University Malaysia only, and are not transferable to Monash University Australia. As a scholarship recipient, you will need to maintain satisfactory academic progress. Failure to do so may result in your Scholarship being terminated. You must not be in receipt of any form of sponsorship from other sources.

## **EnglT Teaching and Research Scholarship**

### **Description:**

 The graduate research student (GRS) supported by this scholarship (i.e. T&R Scholar) is expected to contribute in a formal teaching and gain a record of teaching experience.





- Contribute an average of ten (10) hours of teaching related activities per week, including eight
   (8) contact hours in tutorial or lab sessions during teaching periods of semesters. Lecturing is possible for an outstanding candidate.
- Engage in other teaching related activities, such as marking during the examination period,
   etc.
- Teaching duties will be assigned for two semesters per year.
- Attend training in teaching workshops provided by the School and University, and meet the minimum performance standard (SETU).
- The teaching assignment will be managed by Deputy HoS (Education) in School of Engineering or Associate HoS (Education) in School of Information Technology respectively.

### **Avaliability:**

 Applications are open in April and December, every year. Successful applicants must submit formal application for PhD before March or July of the academic year.

#### **Benefits:**

- Each scholarship comes with the following for up to three years and three months full-time equivalent from the date of course commencement until the scholarship end date or upon thesis submission; whichever is earlier:
- o 100% tuition fee waiver; and
- Monthly stipend of RM3,640

#### **Eligibilty:**

- The applicant must meet the entry requirements for PhD studies, and meet the eligibility for the Campus Graduate Research Excellence Scholarship (link), which includes H1/H1E from their Bachelor degree.
- In addition, the applicant must also possess a Master degree (by coursework or research) in a relevant discipline (engineering, computer science or information technology), and be able to obtain a Teaching Permit from the Ministry of Higher Education.
- The application is open to Malaysians only.
- o The main supervisor for the PhD study must be first engaged before submitting an application.



Prior experience in teaching is not mandatory but an advantage.

- c. Academic Transcripts with grading scales
- d. Research output (publications, patents, and etc.)
- e. Two referee letters
- f. Research Proposal
- g. Support Letter by the Main Supervisor from the respective School





- Applications must be submitted using the form provided by the School.
- Only applications with complete supporting documents will be processed.
- Only shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview.
- The final decision of the application will be made by the Head of School (HoS).

- This bursary is open to:Monash Alumni graduating from the Australian, South African or Malaysian campuses.
- o Benefits: 10% waiver of the course fee.

### **Eligibilty:**

- You must be enrolled into one of the following courses:
- Master of Business Information Systems
- Master of Communications and Media Studies
- Master of International Business
- Master of Professional Counselling

You are not permitted to take on other financial assistance at any point of your studies.

  All applications for admission consistent with the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered automatically for the bursary.
